**LATEST SWANAGE RAILWAY DVDS**

**STEAM AT SWANAGE** 85mins £12.95

This DVD from Online, is a re-mastered recording originally issued in 1990 on video tape. It covers B.R. steam trains in the 1960s. the last train from Furzebrook sidings, B.R. DEMUs just after closure in 1969 and the narrow gauge clay mine railway, still running nearby. After which the early days of the preservation movement are seen including the launching of *257 Squadron*, B4 from the Bluebell railway, 8F 45160, two 'Jinties', G.W.R 5619, 'Cunarder', Austerity 'Whiston' and preserved DEMU 'Thumper'.

**THE SWANAGE RAILWAY STORY** priced at £16.60

This long awaited release, which includes archive footage, will allow us to follow the many ups and downs the railway has lived through, from BR days through preservation to the present day.

The British Film Institute has now released *BFI Collection Vol.9, Just the Ticket*. Featured are classics such as *Just Like the Rest of Us*, the first ever BFI film *Berth 24*, as well as rare gems like *Give Your Car a Holiday* and *Go As You Please in Britain*. This double DVD box set includes, thirteen films made between 1950 and 1983. Volumes 1 to 8 are also available at £19.58 each.

**THE BRITISH TRANSPORT FILMS COLLECTION BOX SET**. 38 hours, 125 films. This impressive 18-disc box set collects all nine volumes of the BFI's celebrated British Transport Films series, and fully illustrates the wide range of subjects the BTF unit covered for over three decades. Price: £97.90

Also from the *British Film Institute* is a Collectors Edition DVD called ***NIGHT MAIL*** priced at £15.66 (116 minutes). Included is *Night Mail* (1936), *Spotlight on the Night Mail* (1948), *Thirty Million Letters* (1963), *Night Mail 2* (1986) and *Way to the Sea* (1936).

The *Night Mail* film has been re-mastered digitally and restored, with music by Benjamin Britten and poetry by W.H.Auden. It is an account of the operation of the Royal Mail train delivery service and shows various stages and procedures of that operation.

As the train nears its destination there is a sequence, in which Auden's spoken verse and Britten's music are combined over a montage of racing train wheels. The DVD comes with a booklet with essays by author Blake Morrison.

**QUARRY HUNSLETS TODAY** 97 minutes £17.58

The Quarry Hunslets of North Wales were all 0-4-0 saddle tanks designed for use on the 2' gauge quarry lines of the slate industry. They were built over a lengthy period from the 1880s until 1932. There were eight different sub classes, with small engines for use in the quarries and larger engines used on the tramways and main line. Many of these locomotives have been preserved and work today in museums and tourist lines across Britain.

**SIR NIGEL GRESLEY ON THE MAIN LINE** 89 minutes £16.60

Rescued and restored by volunteers, one of the fastest steam locomotives ever built, returns to the place it was made for, the main line. We're on the footplate as the classic A4 faces a demanding test run to gain approval for running over Network Rail. We then travel with the loco on its nostalgic return to King's Cross and an emotional reunion with three other survivors of the class at York. There is also footage of *Oliver Cromwell* and *Scots Guardsman*, as well as fabulous views of *Princess Elizabeth* on the S&C taken from the air!

This colourful pictorial portrait shows how one of the most picturesque stretches of the railway network, primarily the section between Starcross and Bishopsteignton, has evolved and developed over recent years. This is the story of a now-disused branch of the Underground between Holborn and Aldwych.
